




Principle of Mar is essential to understanding Jesus.

The full gospel involves the reconciliation of Yeshua Mar with Yeshua Na-im.






## Yeshua Mar: Birth

Matthew 27:34




Bitterness was a part of the Jesus' experience.

Could the call to humility be a call to accept bitterness, which serves as a safeguard against idolatry?



Only when Yeshua Mar is accepted can Yeshua Na-im emerge.


Mark 16:1

Re-examine Jesus in the desert with Sa-tan through the lens of bitterness.


Now when the tempter came to Him, he said, "If You are the Son of God, command that these stones become bread."

Take away the bitterness of hunger
